Methodology

- 1 Development of the 'Structures' and 'Staff' questionnaires as part of a collaborative process:
 - Steering Committee (network heads and national federations)
 - Methodological and operational support for the Savoie Mont-Blanc University survey centre
- 2 Distribution of online questionnaires from 16 May to 13 November 2024 :
 - Mails sent (MESH and MeT contact database)
 - Relay via the members of the steering committee and the Ministry of Culture (DRAC)

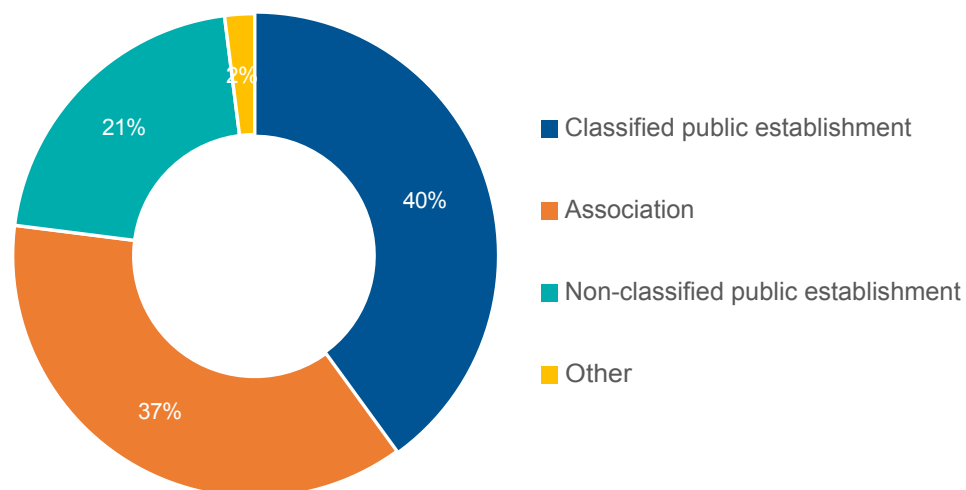

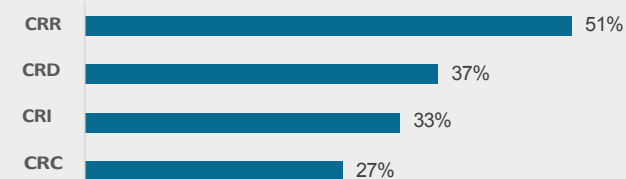

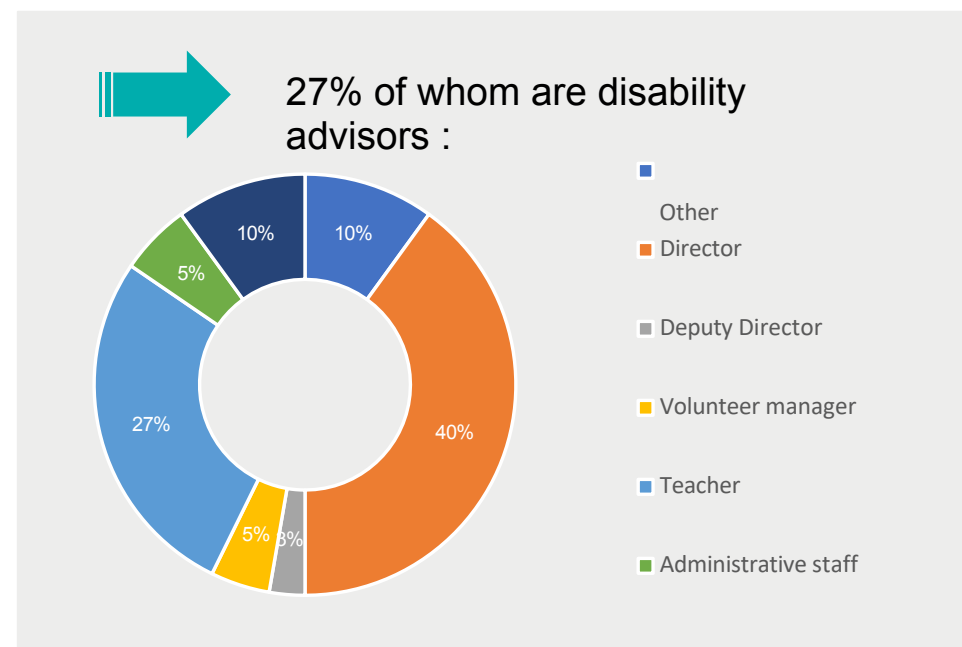
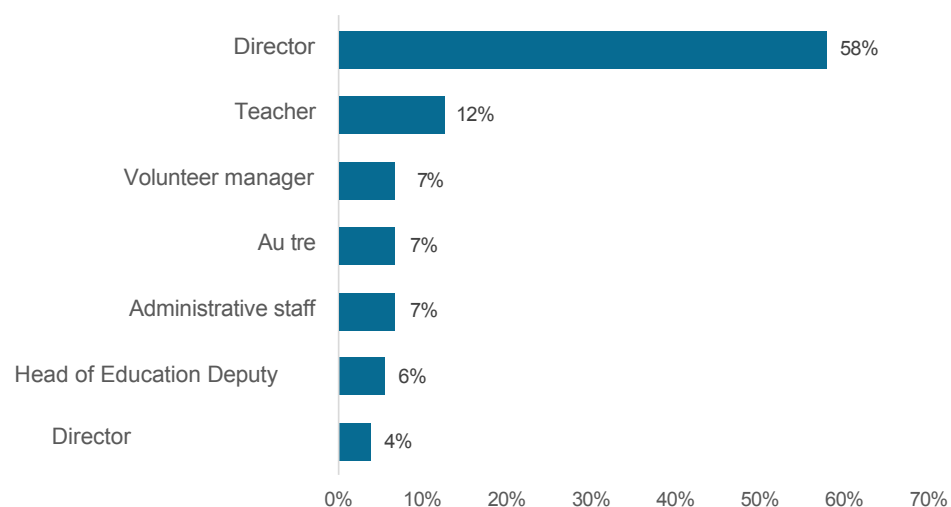
Geographical origin

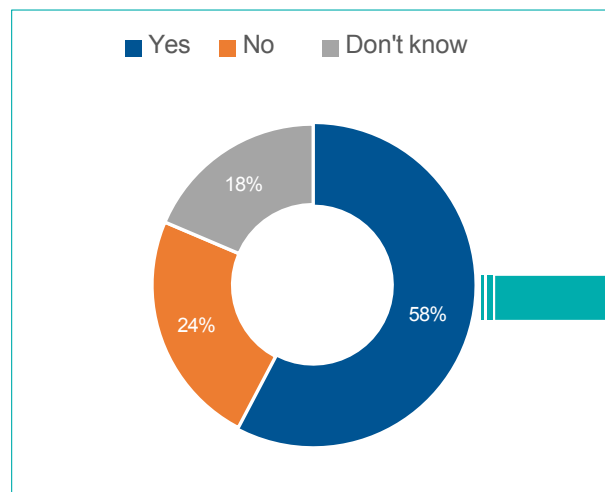
Respondents' main function

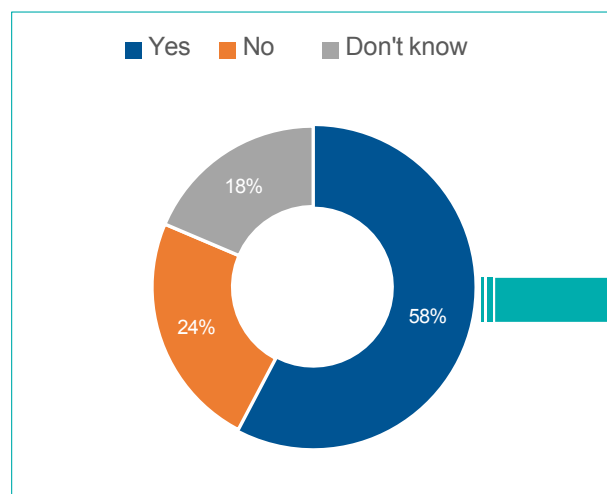

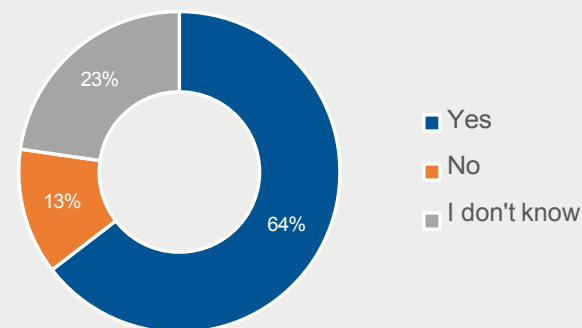

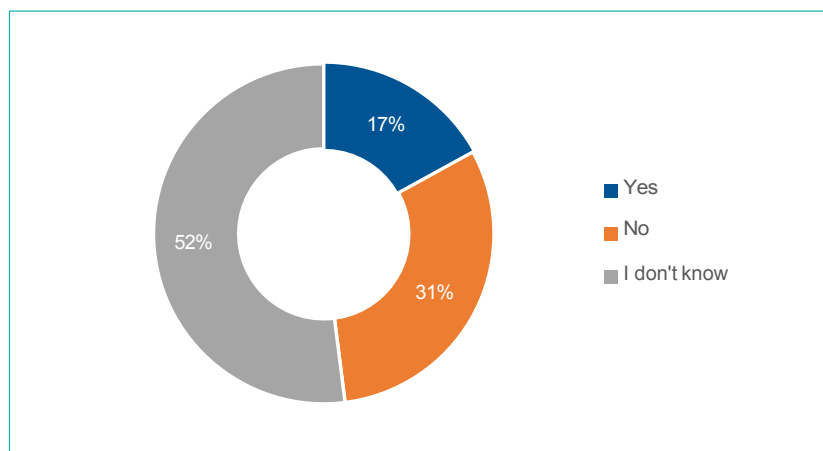

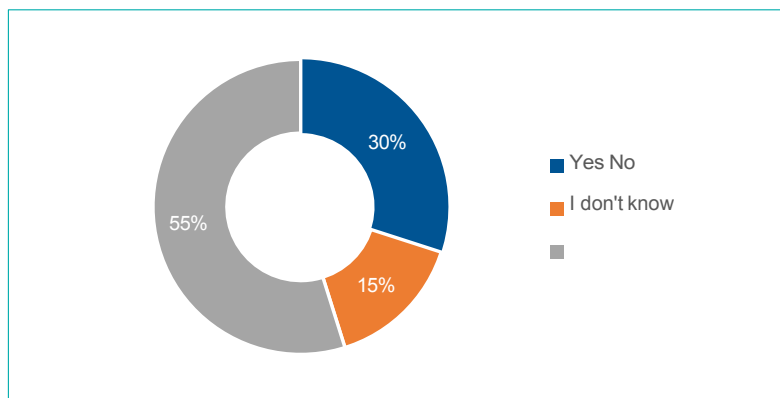

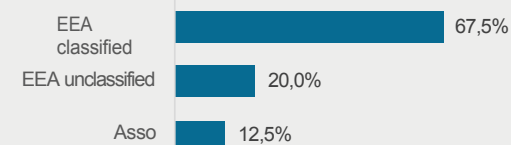

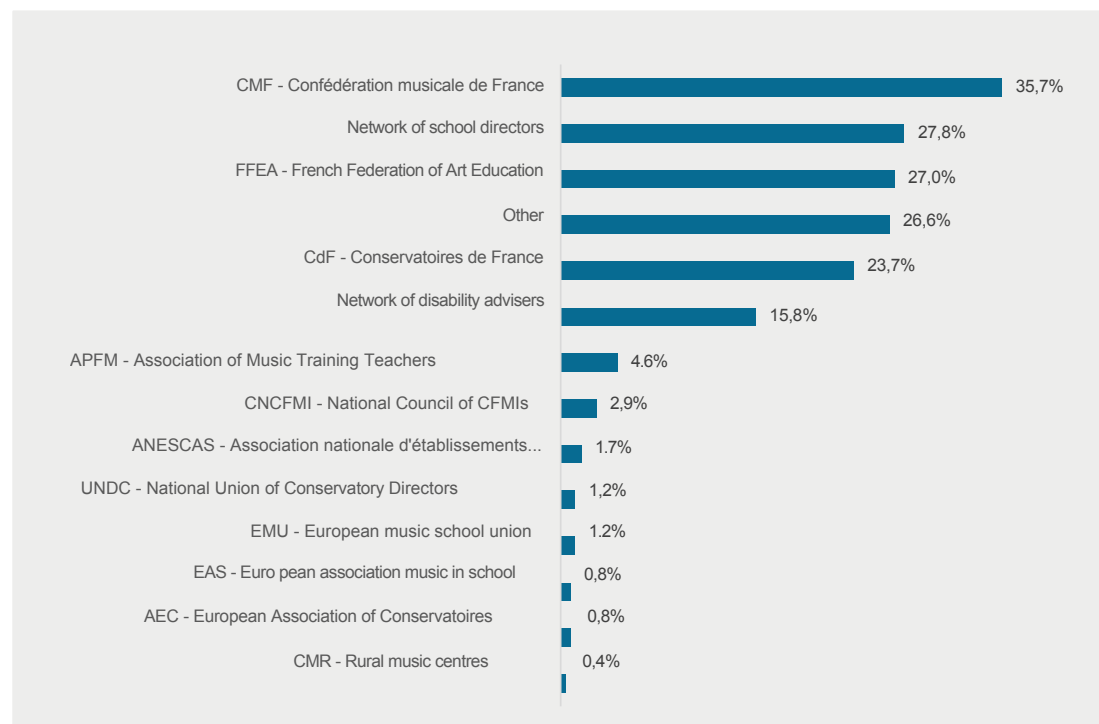

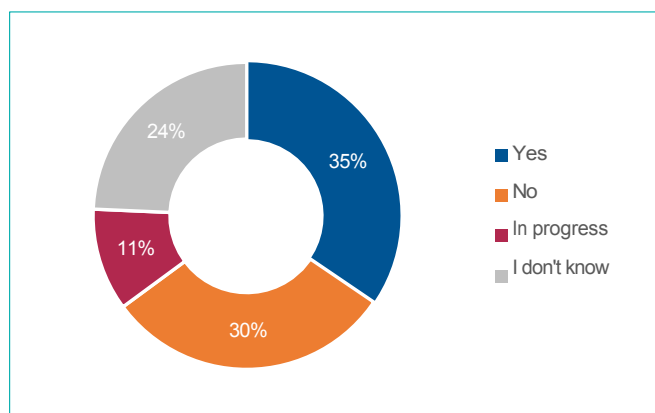

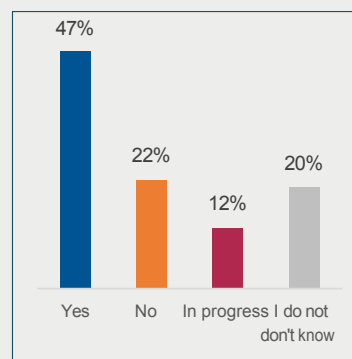

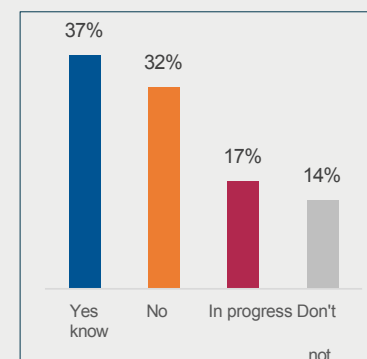

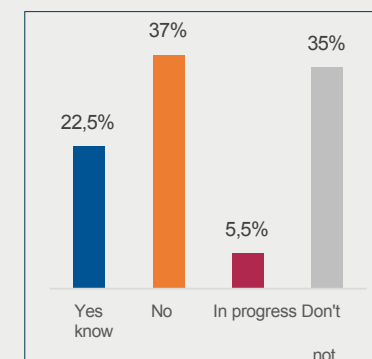

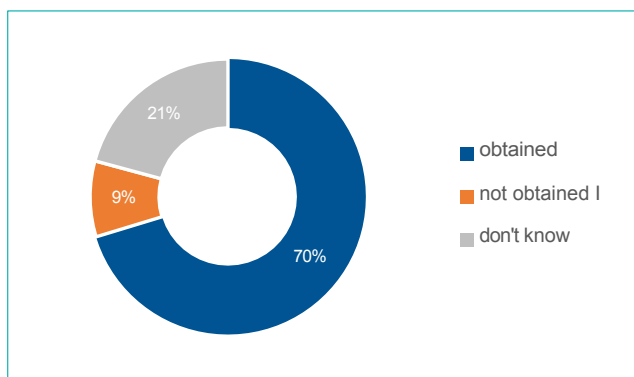

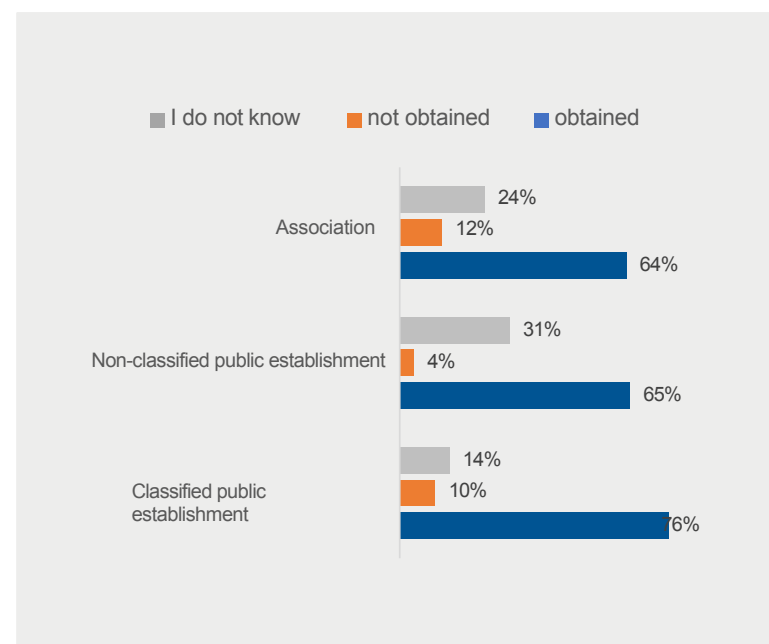

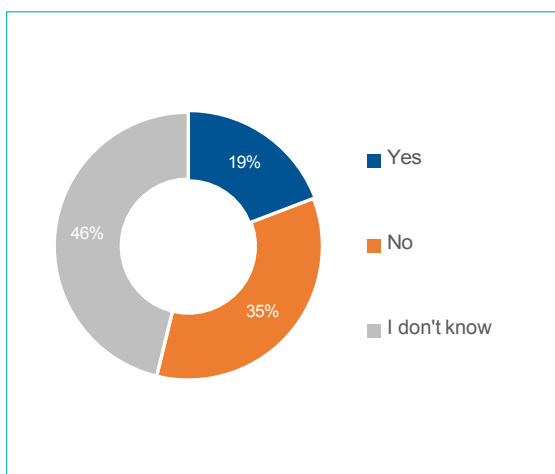

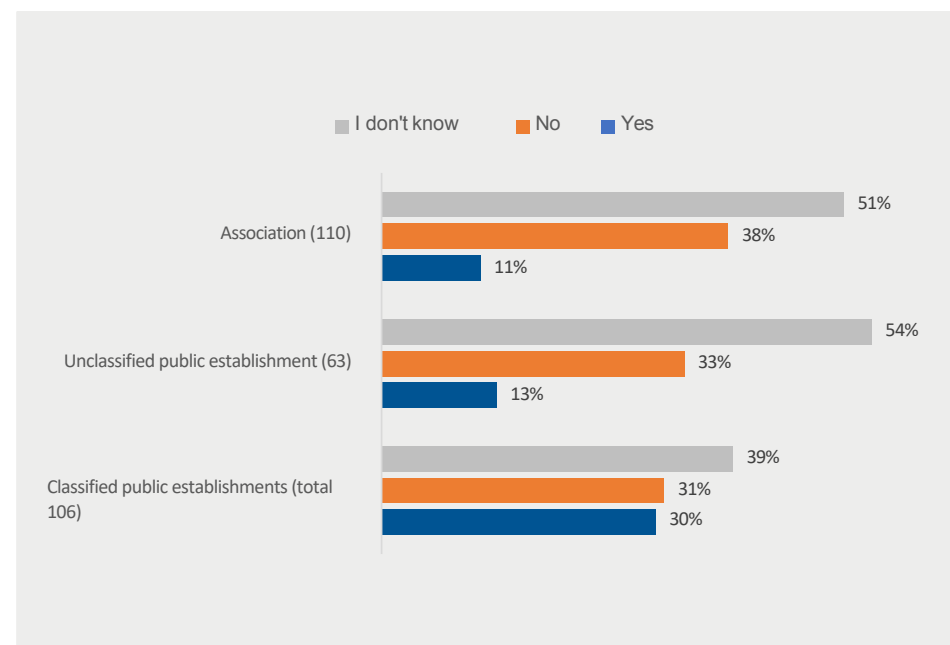

Public Accessibility Register (RPA)

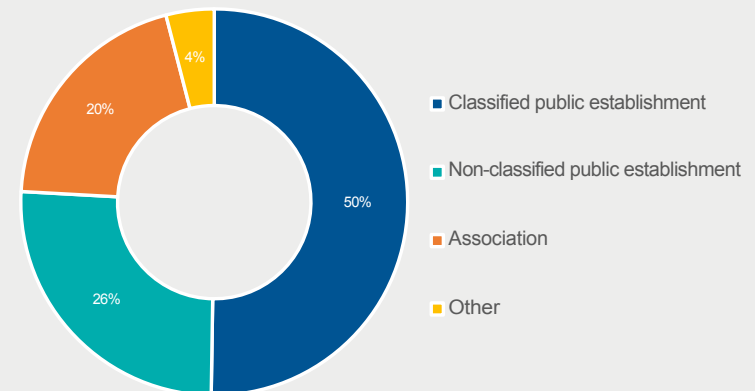

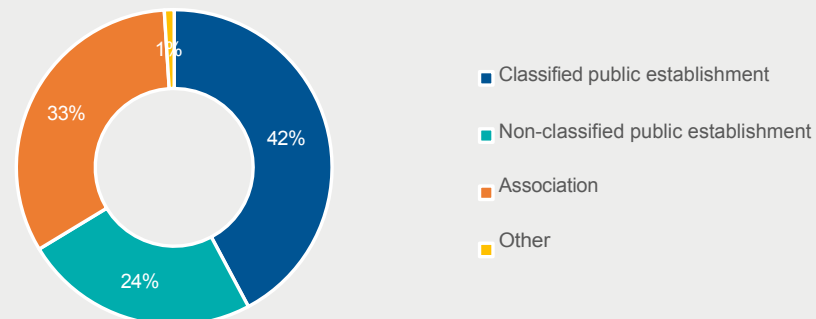
Skills development plan

Taking skills into account when recruiting

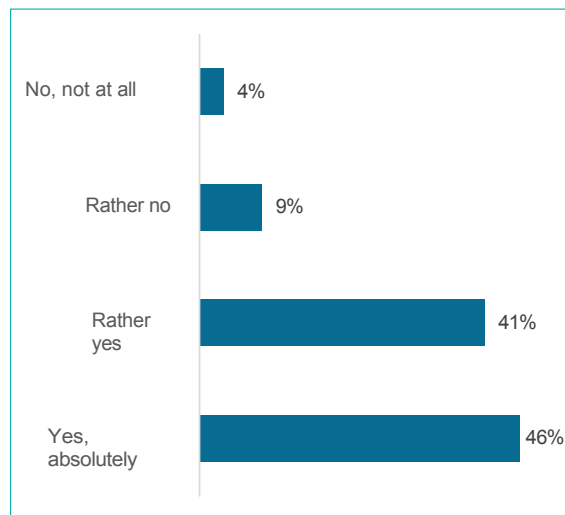

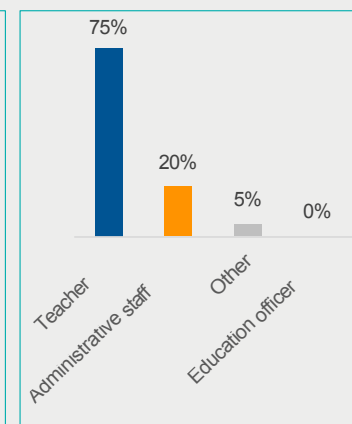

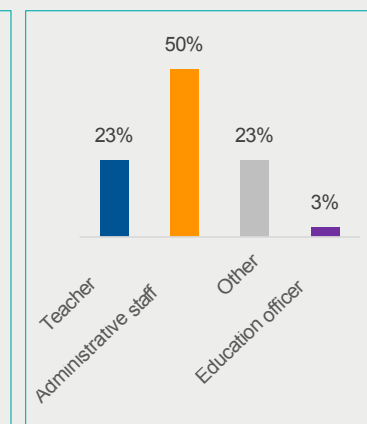
Disability advisor - Main function

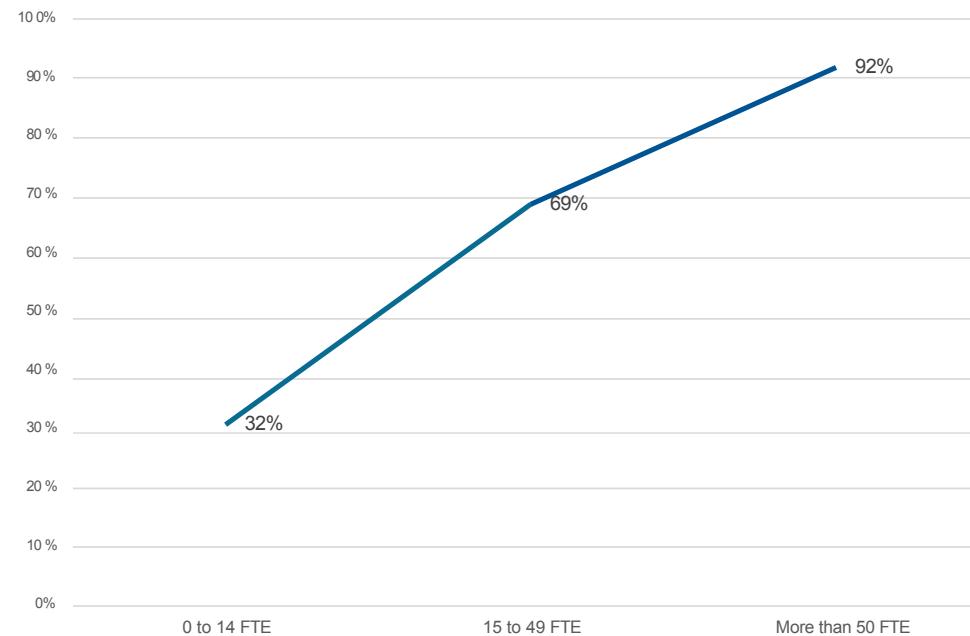

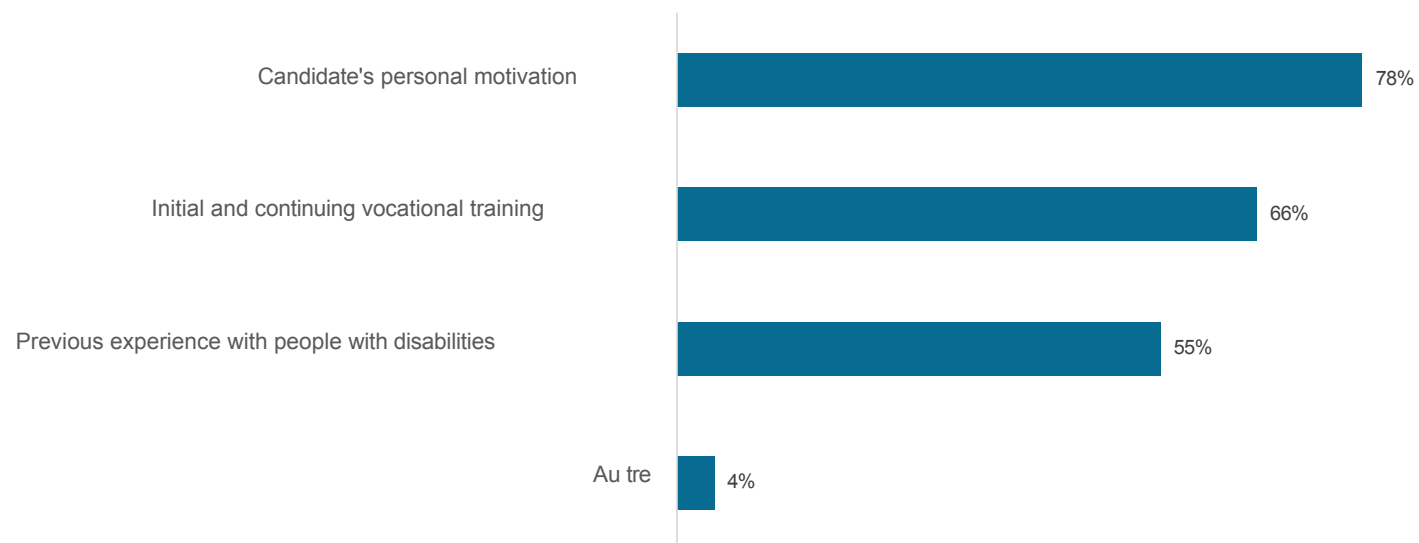

Disability Advisor - FTE



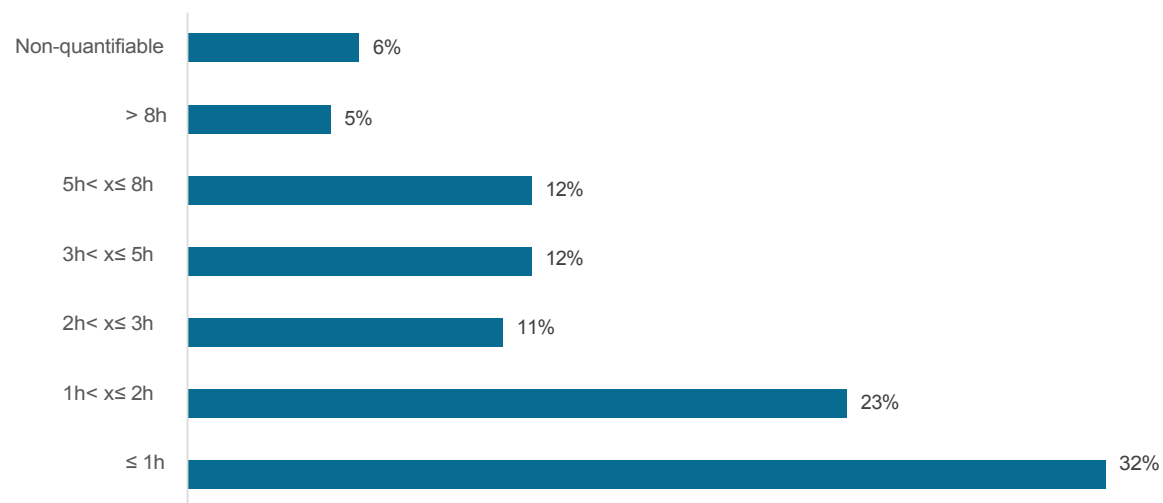

Disability advisor - Selection criteria



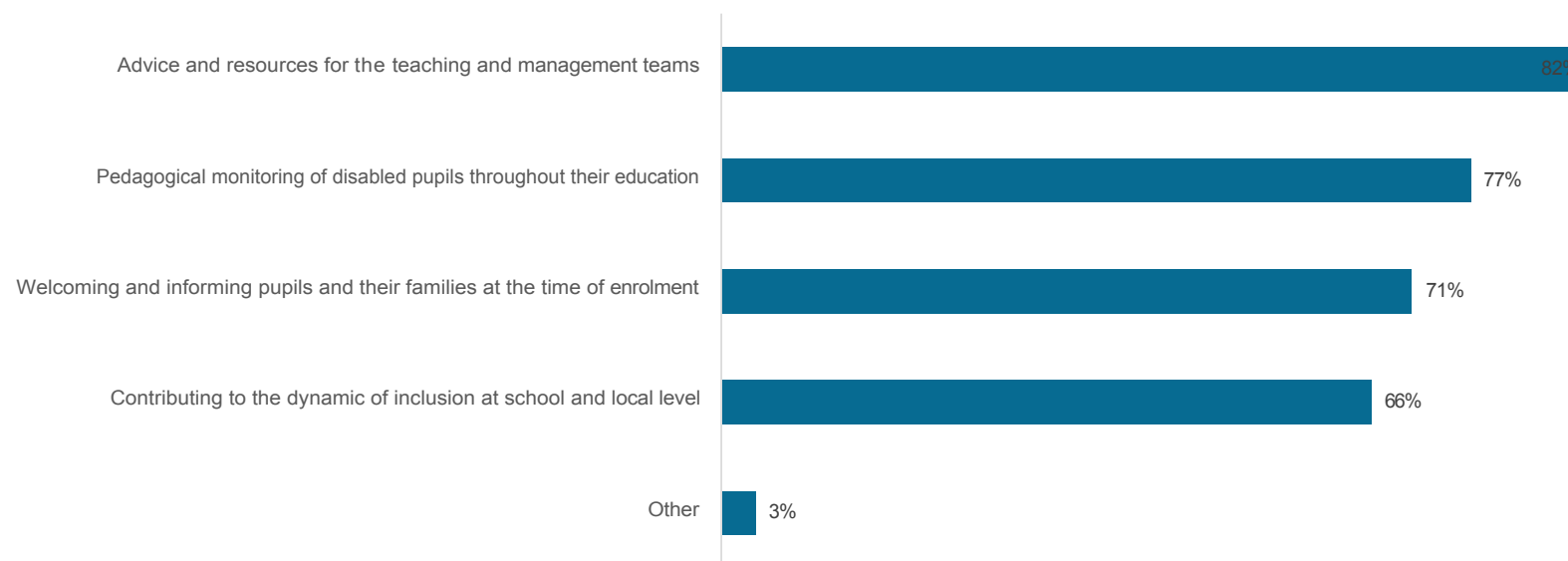

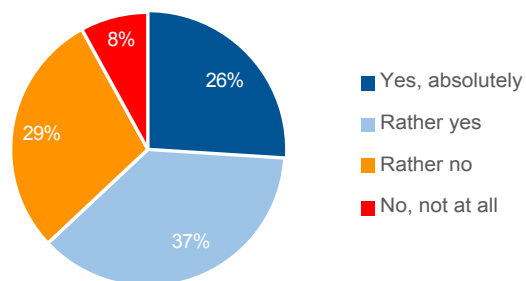

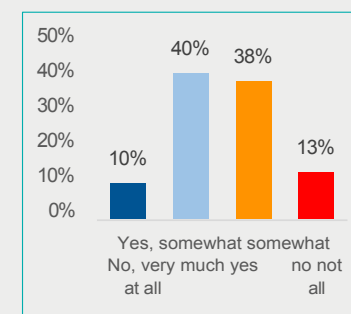

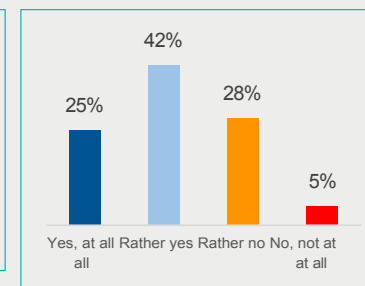
Disability advisor - Need for professional certification



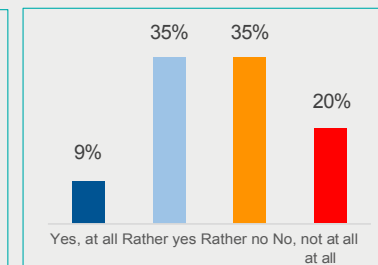

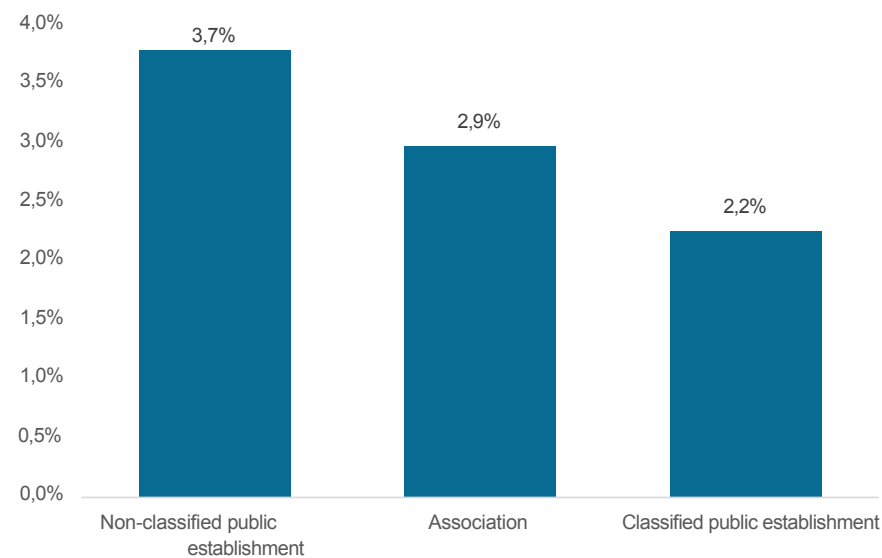

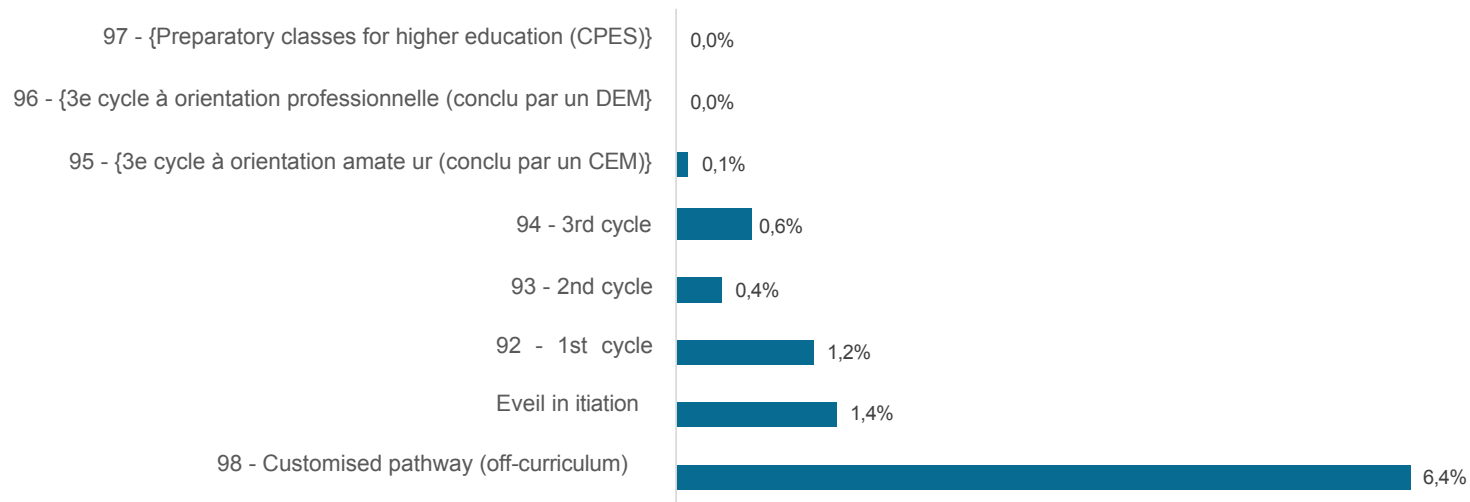

Rates by course/cycle



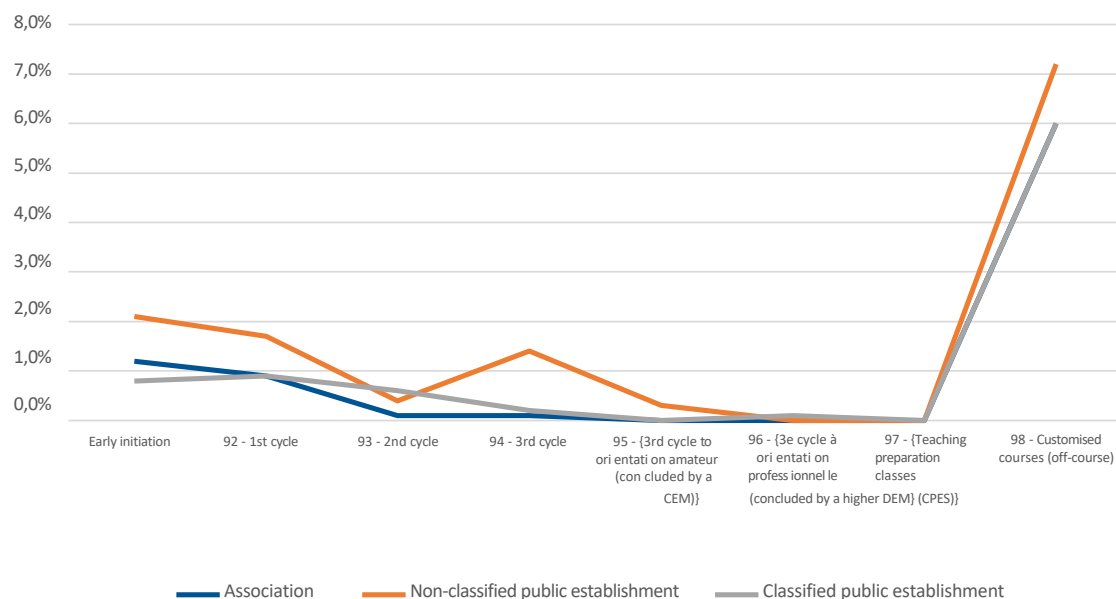

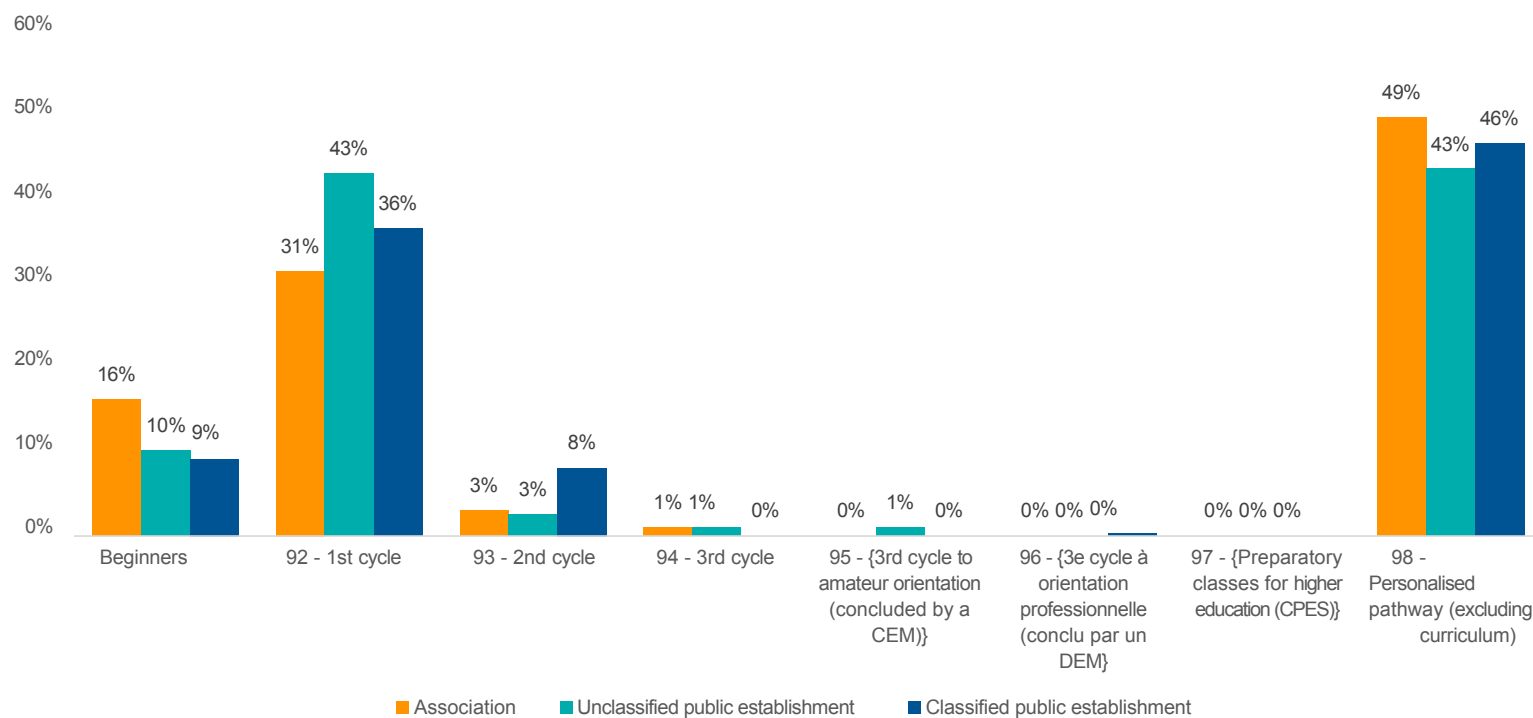

Breakdown by pathway/cycle (PSH staff only)



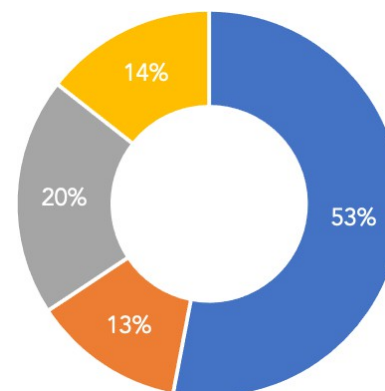

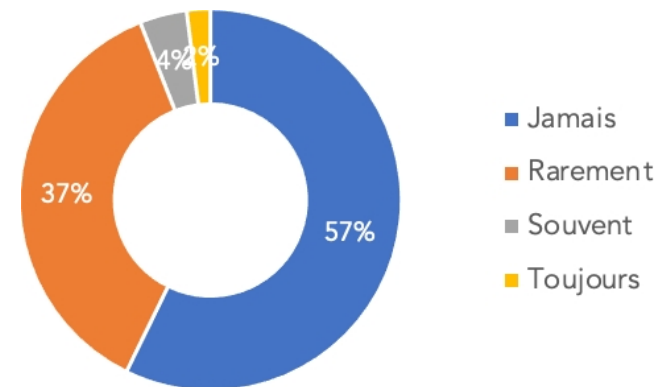

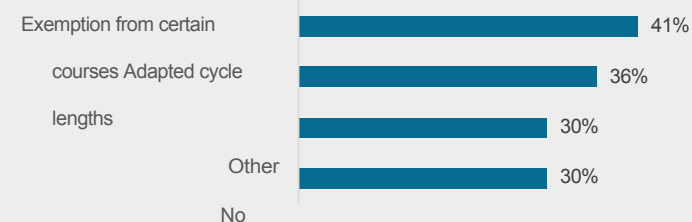

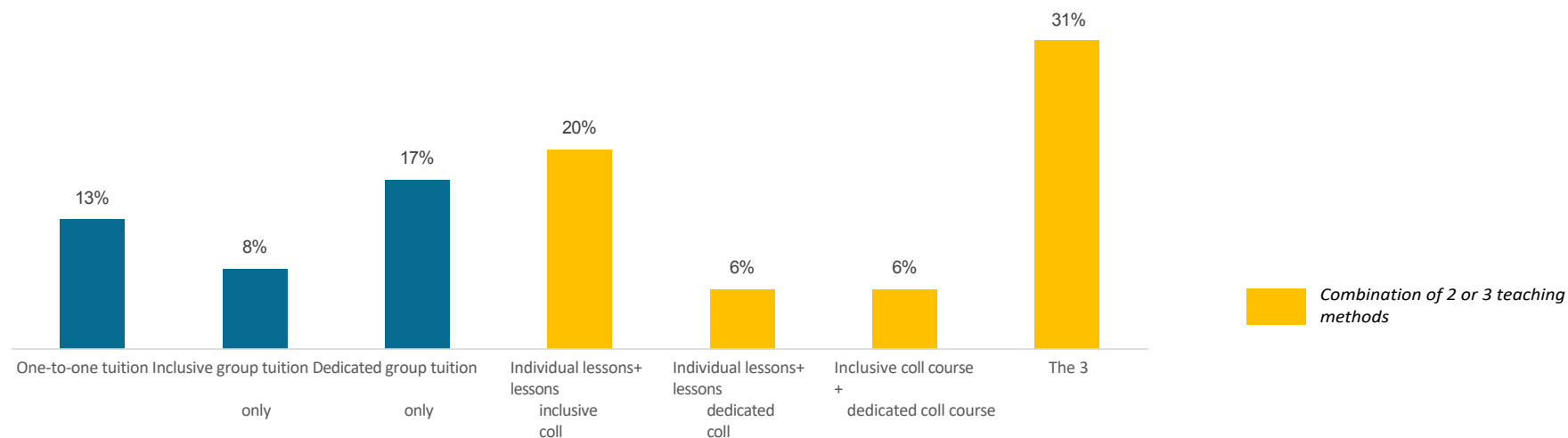

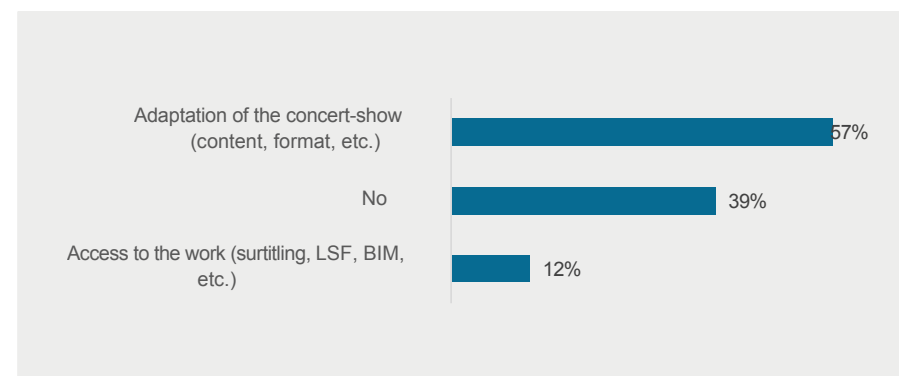

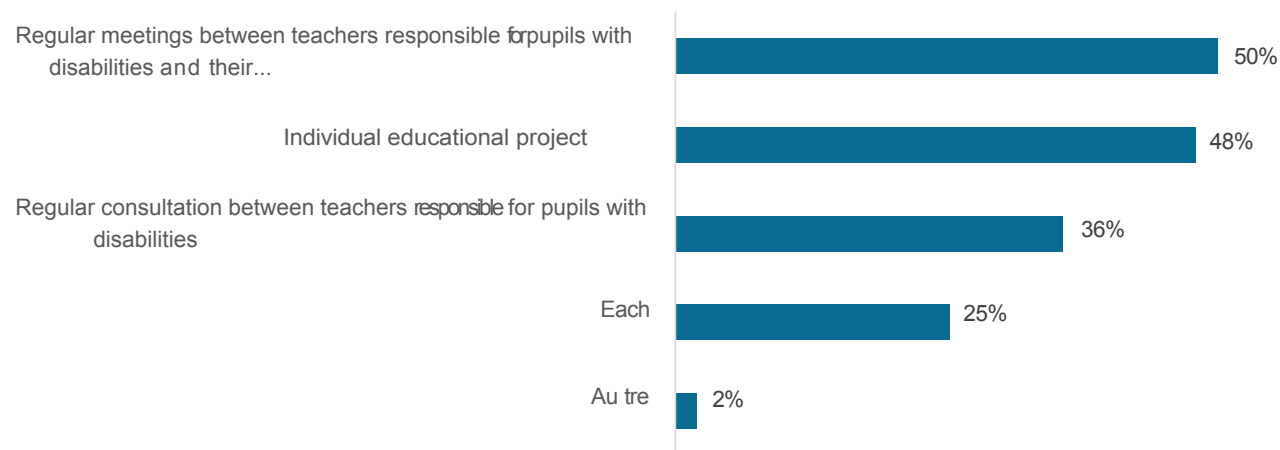

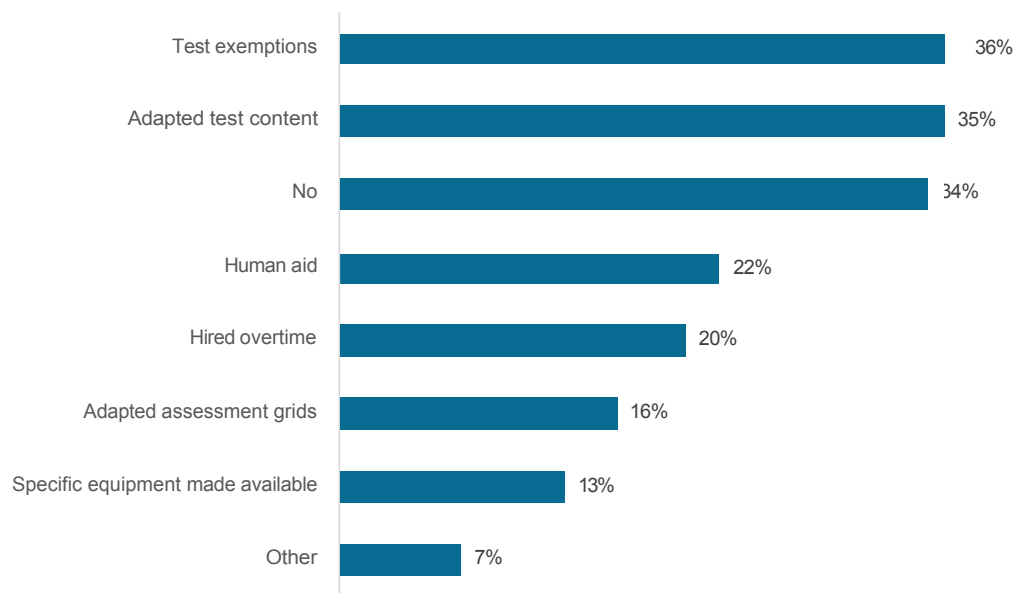

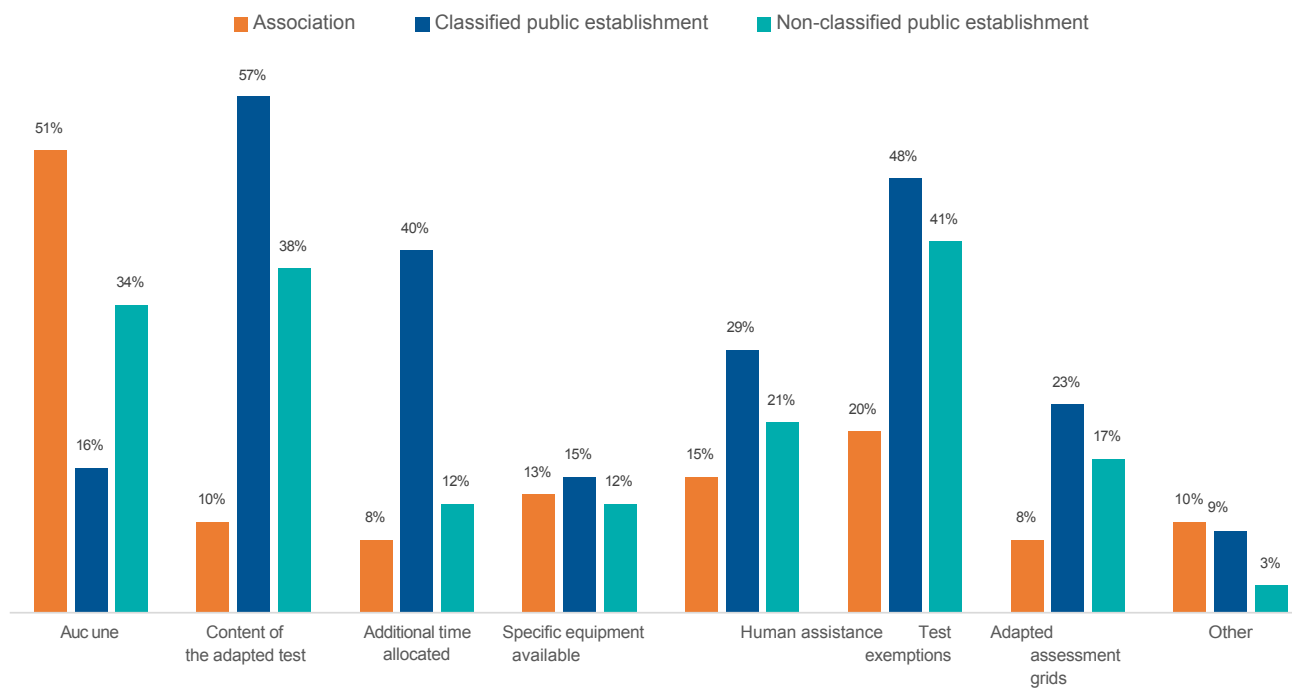

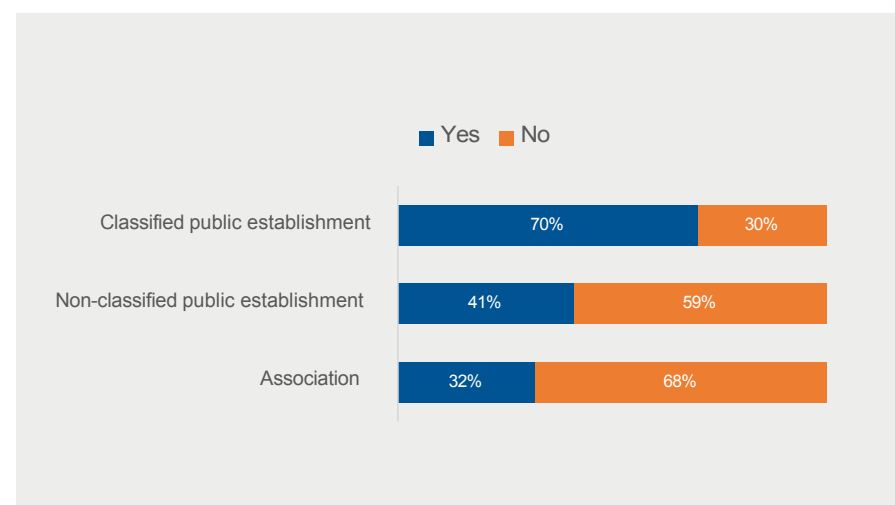

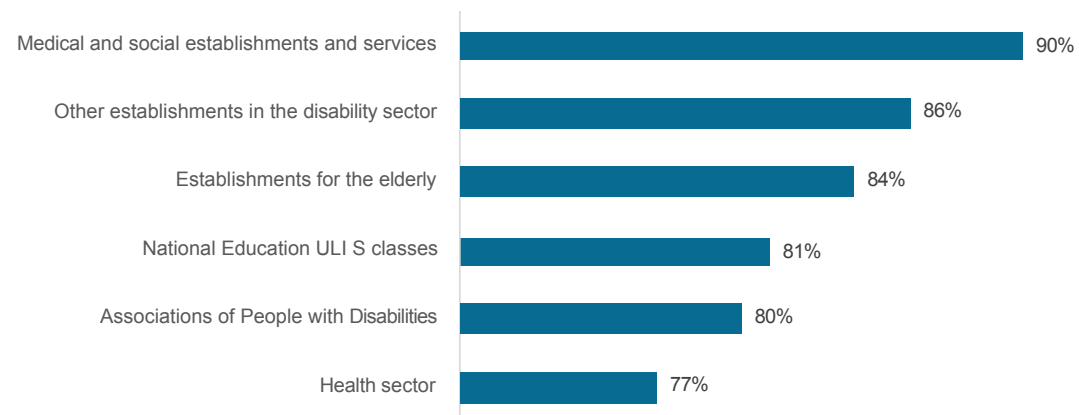

Types of partners

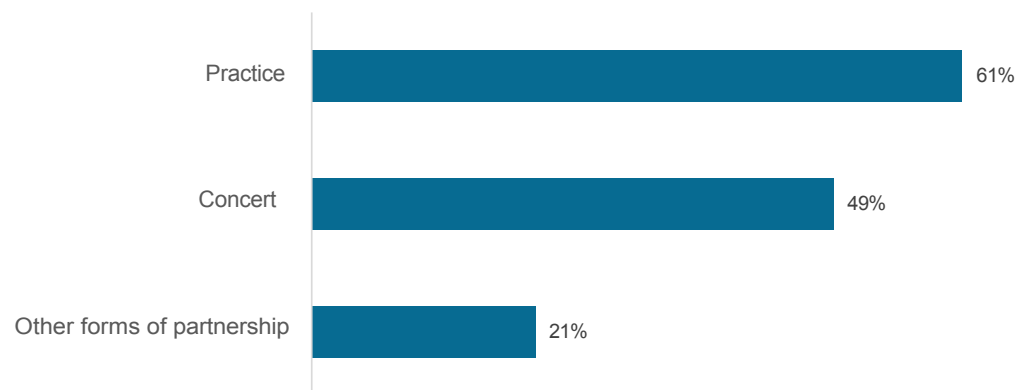

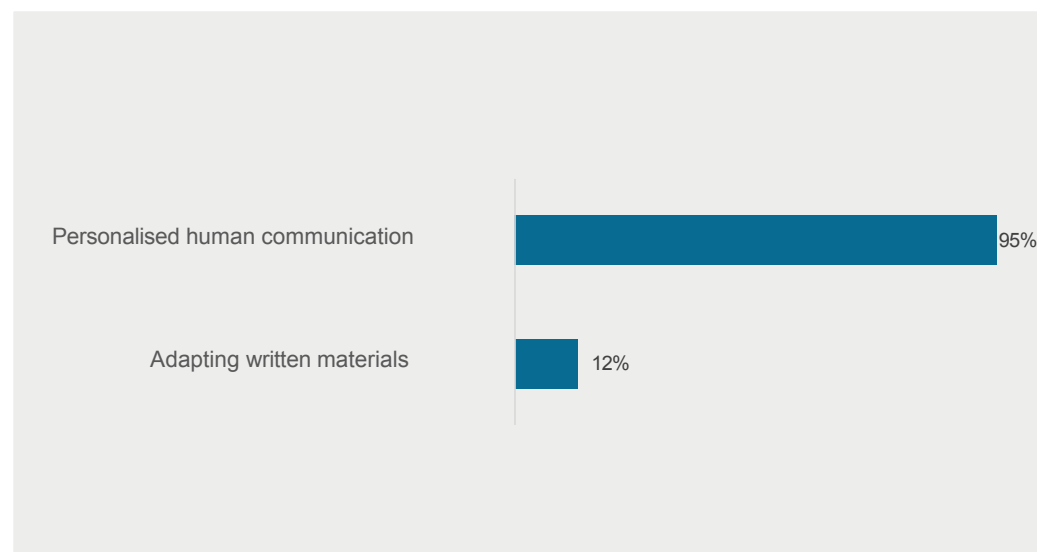

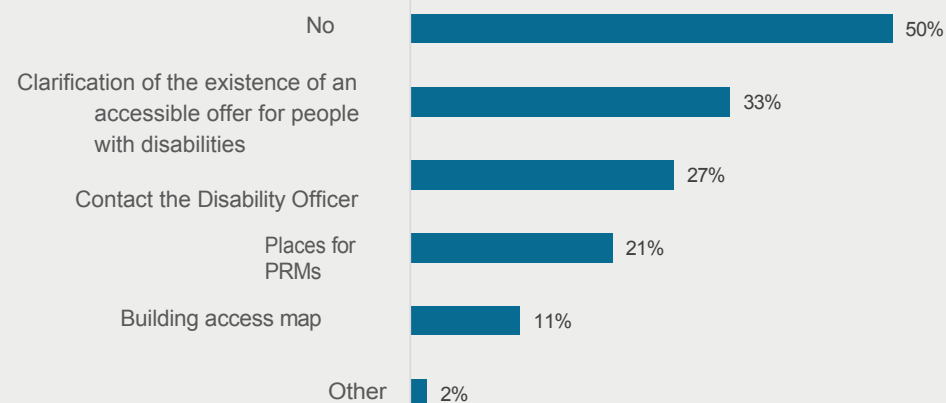

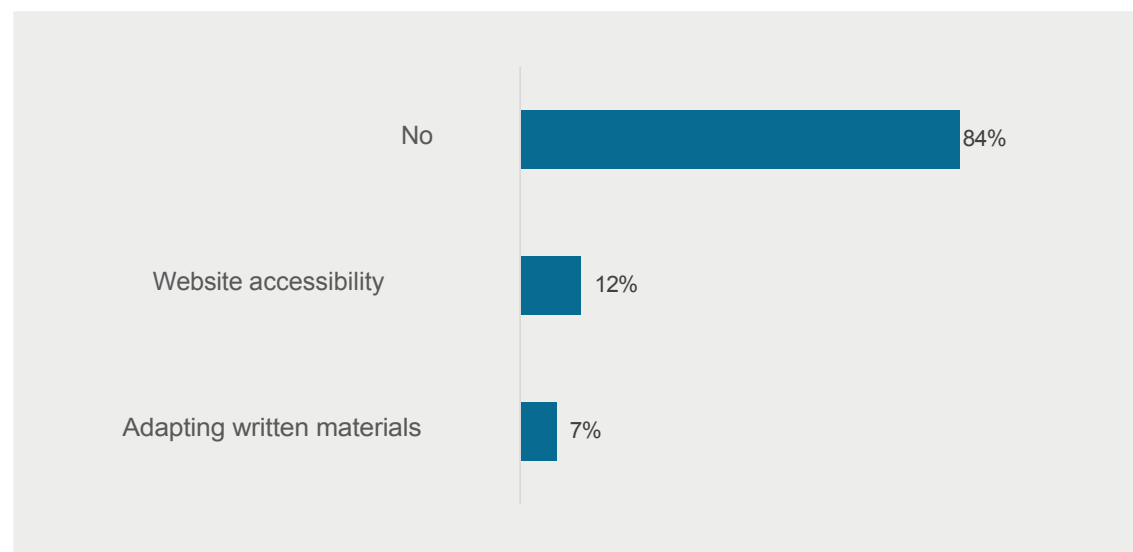

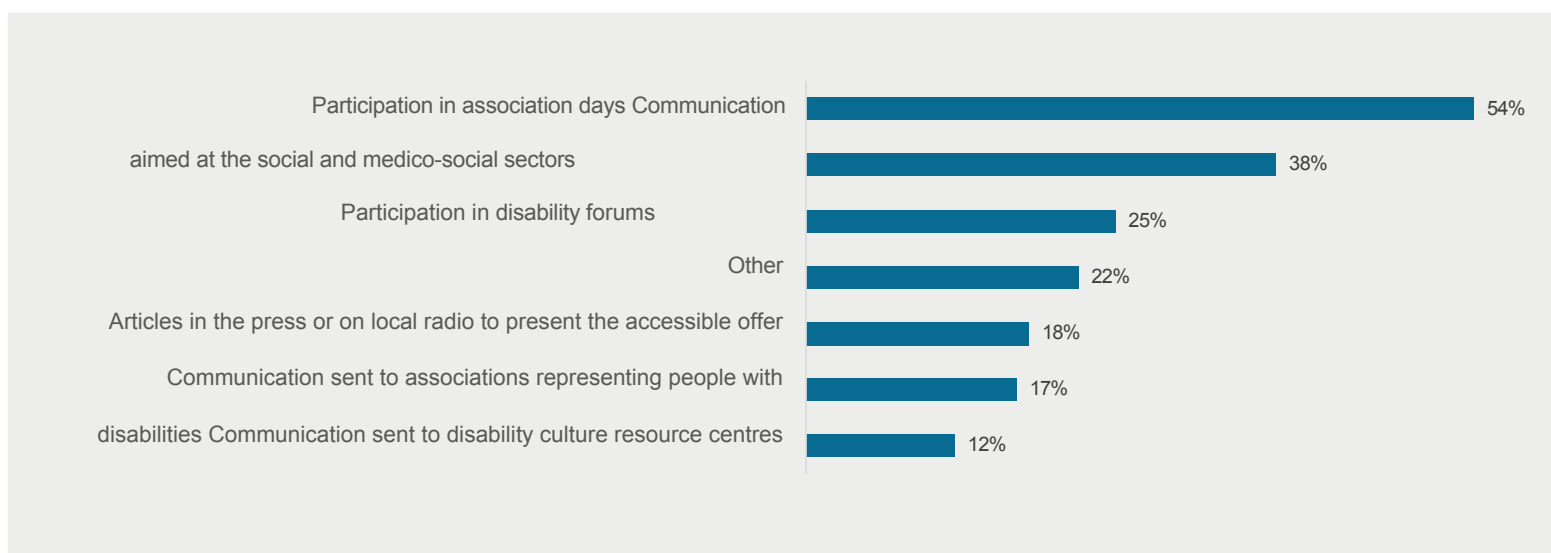

2 Facilitating factors

— a r t i s t i c a l i n c l u s i o n

Objective

Identify the factors impacting on inclusive dynamics within a music teaching establishment

Resource

Develop an indicator that can be used to distinguish between different levels of efficiency in the care of people with disabilities:

- Selection of a set of variables that encompasses the entire inclusive process
- Identification of objective and measurable variables

Variable selection

- HR policy (criterion 1)
- Receiving applications for PSH enrolment (criterion 2)
- Identifying specific needs (criterion 3)
- Adapting assessments (criterion 4)



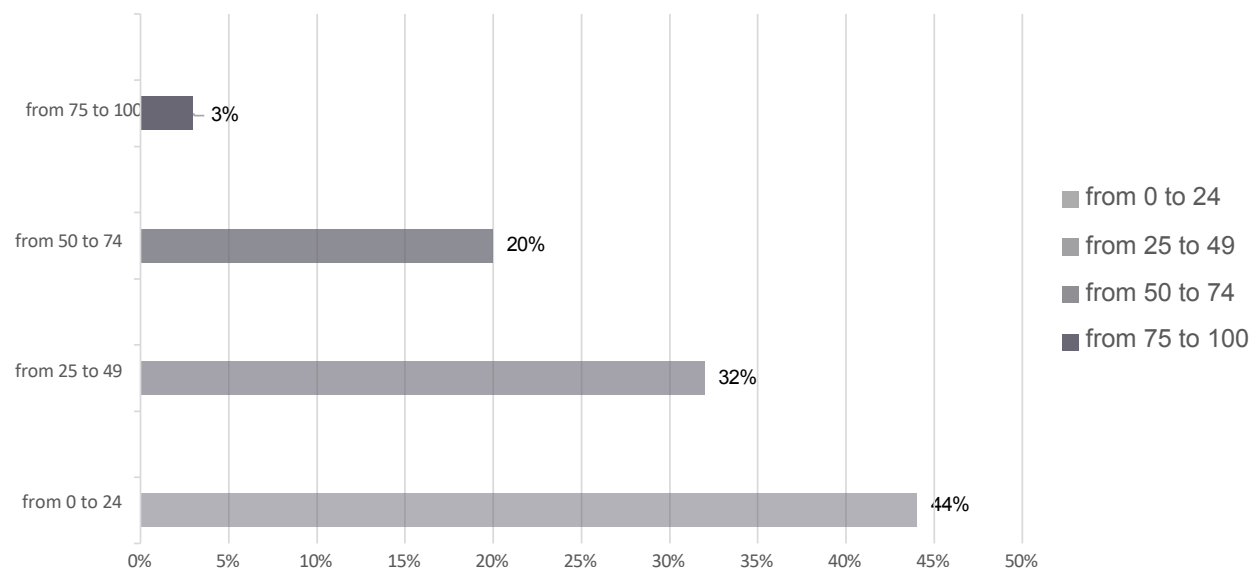
Weight of each variable 25%

Indicator scale

From 0 to 24	Weak inclusive dynamics	1
From 25 to 49	Medium inclusive dynamics	2
From 50 to 74	Strong inclusive momentum	3
From 75 to 100	Very strong inclusive momentum	4

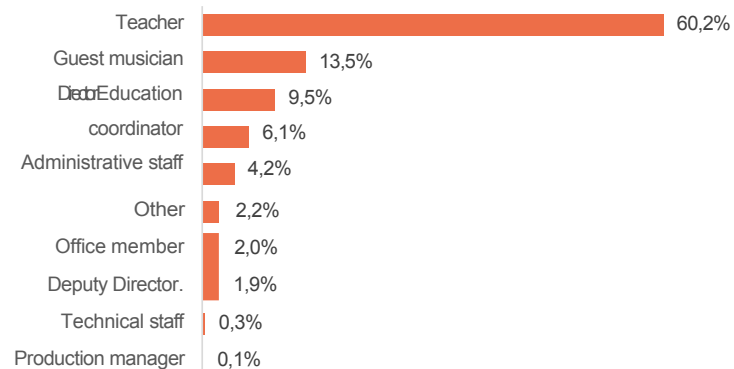

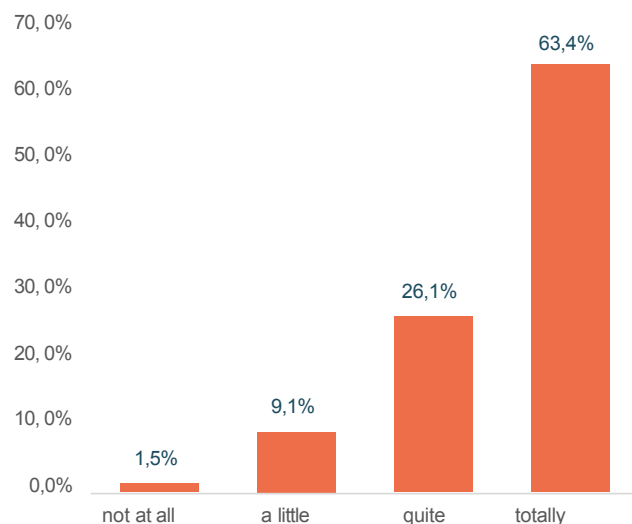

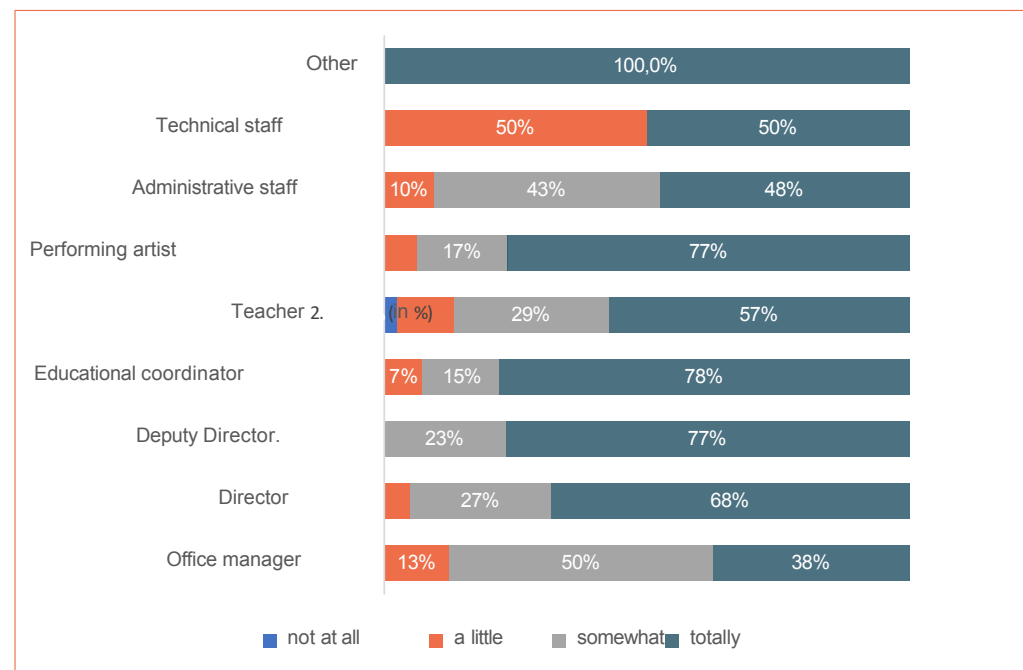

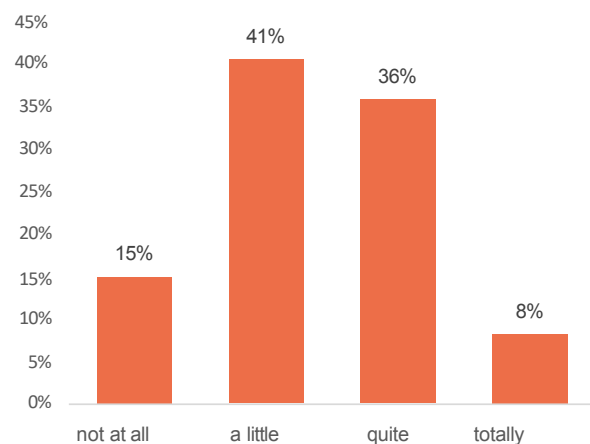
By main function

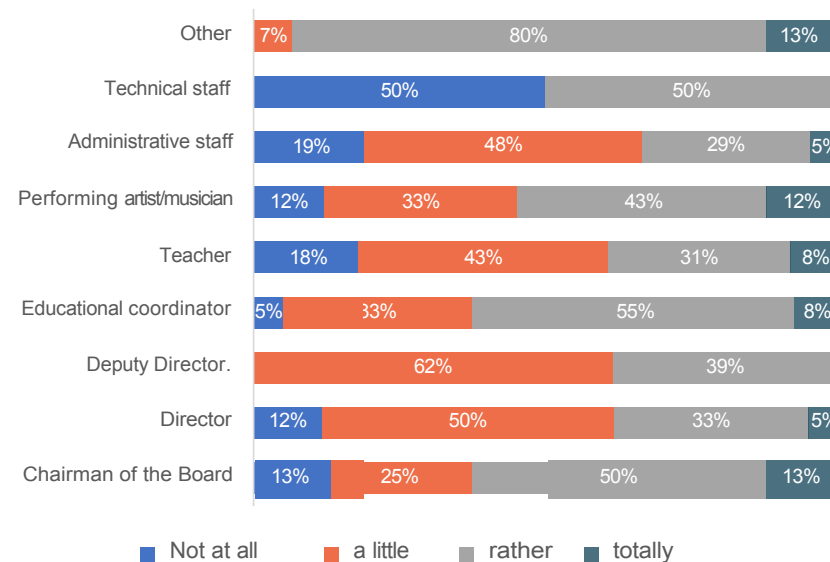

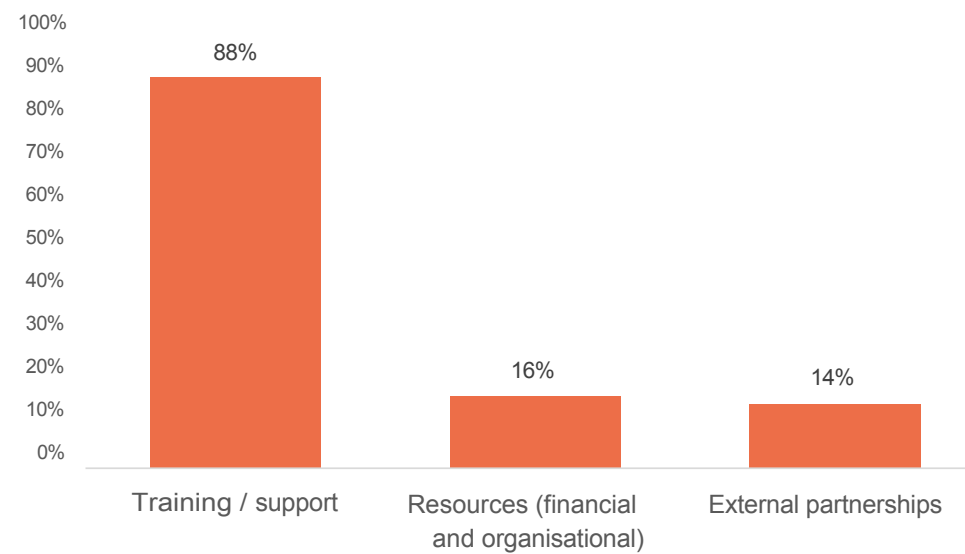

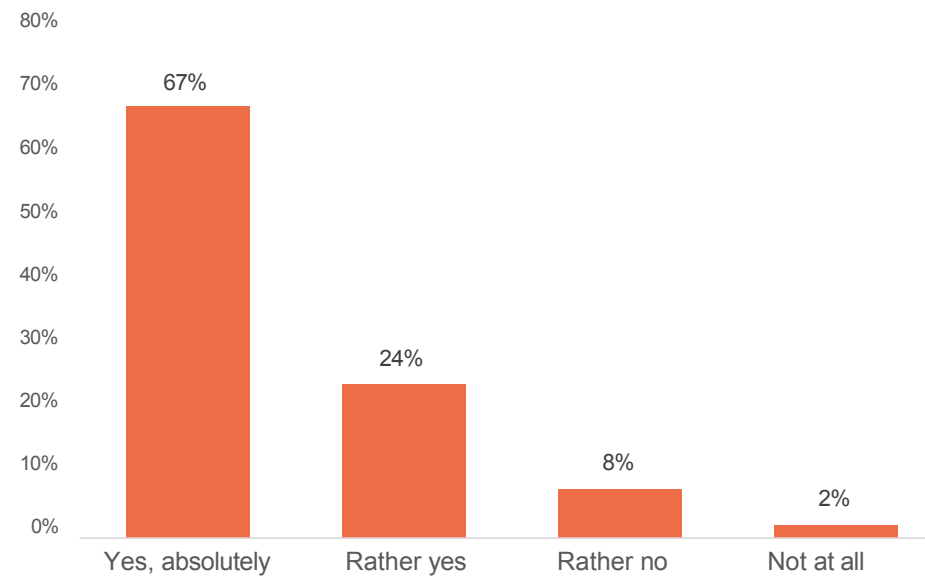

Do you think it is necessary to have a disability officer in your organisation?

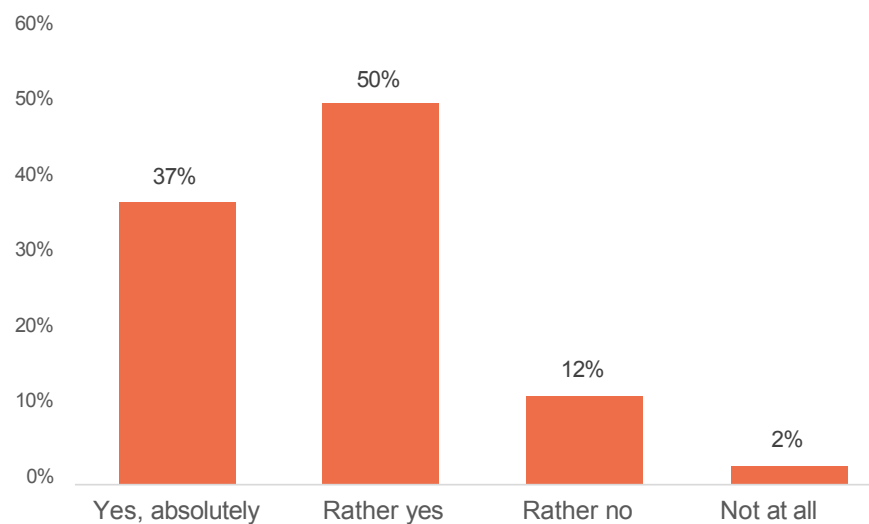

Do you think it is necessary to create a certificate or diploma for disability advisers?

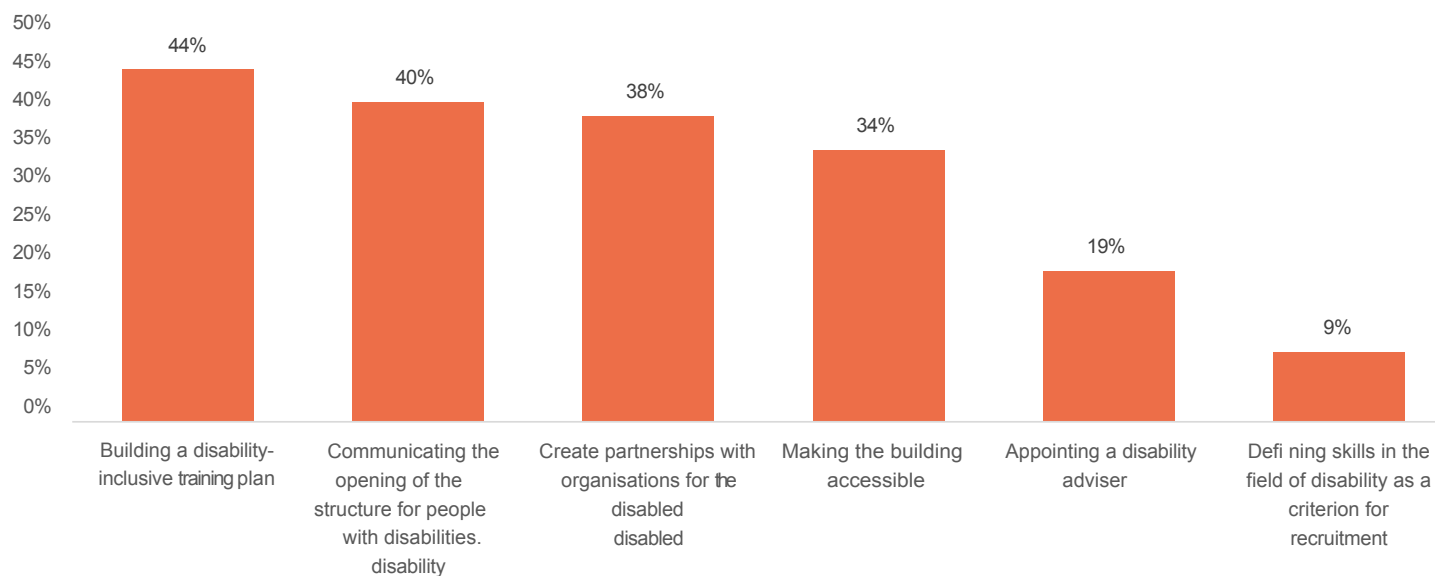
